August 28, 2023

Meeting was called to order at 1908 hours by the Senior Vice Commander.

Roll of Post officers was called with all officers and Executive Committee members present with the excused absence of the Commander and Executive Committee Members Kori Bookman and Robert Thomas.

The Sgt at Arms introduced Chris Bersett of Quilts of Valor.

The Commander Pro Temp turned the floor over to Ms. Bersett for her presentation of the Quilts of Valor program. She provided the history and purpose of the organization and stated that they presented 10 quilts per year to nominated veterans. Only one quilt per veteran can be awarded. She said they still needed 4 names for this year and asked for names membership felt worthy of this honor. The Adjutant has the contact information and will compile a list if anyone is nominated.

The **Membership Report** was given with 90 paid members for the new membership year. New member Lachelle Stevenson was introduced.

Finance Report – The Post's accounts have been consolidated at Regions bank. The Finance Officer reported there was \$7.091.98 in checking and \$3,722.78 in savings for a total of \$10,814.66. A breakdown of individual program funds still needs to be verified, however the Visiting Veterans program did show a balance of \$144. Robin Latdrick motioned to accept subject to audit and was seconded by Chip Barber. Membership approved.

Poppies – Currently we have one date set for 14 October at the Lowes across from SWIC.

Veteran Affairs – Doug Jameson stated the next meeting is 29 August at 7 p.m. and is open to the public. Our primary and alternate representatives are either sick or out of town.

Community Patriotic Observances – Steve Duff will need to confirm the date for the Veterans Day ceremony at Wolf Branch School. Swansea does not have a Veterans Day ceremony so we will attend the Belleville ceremony. Cambridge House requested a flag folding ceremony on 11 September at 1400. Rich Gaebel will take the lead with two other Honor Guard members.

Honor Guard –We will be doing a Color Guard event on 14 October for the Plumbers and Pipefitters anniversary dinner. We still need information for this event.

Americanism – We will be working with VFW Post 1739 on a Blood Drive. We will be trying to schedule for 3-5 February 2024. We need a chair for this event to get it scheduled.
