November 28, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 1905 hours by the Commander.

Roll of Post officers was called Commander Page, Finance Officer Burrack, Sgt at Arms Stacey, (Executive Committee) Andrew Dunham, Kori Bookman, all present. Excused were JrV Martin, Executive Board Member Robert Thomas, Adjutant Devine, and Sgt at Arms Green

The Sgt. At Arms, no guest to introduce. We did have one of our Past Commanders attending, Bill Meister.

October 2022 meeting minutes were read with motion to accept by Steve Duff and seconded by Doug Jameson. Minutes approved by membership.

The Membership Report was given showing the post currently has 120 paid members out of 150, 80%, for the current year. A couple questions concerning Paid Up for Life membership. There were no known reductions in cost at this time.

The Finance Officer provided a breakdown of the post's accounts with \$3,224.16 in Savings and \$9,271.59 in Checking. There is one outstanding check in the amount of \$120 for membership. Motioned to accept, subject to audit by Steve Duff, seconded by Rich Gaebel. Membership approved.

Poppies – Last event was held on November 5th at Menards. We collected \$1,192.22. The Poppy Chair made the recommendation to dispense all funds collected from the three events during 2022 as follows: \$115 each to Camp Hope and USO Missouri; \$200 each to Mayfest, The Joseph Center, Fischer House, Honor Flight of Southern IL, The Haven, Quincy Veterans Home, Anna Veterans Home, and Marion VA Hospital; \$275 each to Gifts to the Yanks and Veterans Visitation, \$298.00 for the purchase of 2000 poppies. \$2.00 will be put in Savings for later use. Mary Monett motioned to expend the funds as noted, seconded by Robin Latdrick, membership approved. Read a letter from Menards about the comments made about Anson at Menards. Steve Duff asked to see if he could get with Schnuck's Staff to schedule a Poppy Day. He was encourage to try.
